1. Legal Information Management & Briefing System (LIMBS):

- I. Purpose: A web-based portal for monitoring court cases where the Union of India is a party.
- II. Operational Since: February 2016, supervised by the Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law and Justice.

2. Progress and Reach:

- I. LIMBS has been implemented across all Ministries, departments, and attached offices of the of Union of India.
- II. Tracks **12,30,868** court cases.
- III. Engages **12879** users
- IV. Engages **7,124** panel advocates for sharing case-related information.
- V. Continues to evolve with user feedback and technological updates.

3. Administration:

- I. **112** Nodal Officers (56 at Joint Secretary level or higher).
- II. **387** Local Administrators.

4. Reports Generated (15+): Various reports by court, status, category, financial implications, advocate, and department, among others.

- Nationwide Implementation:
 - Developed by the Department of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, with NIC (National Informatics Centre).
 - Deployed across all GOI Ministries, Departments, attached offices, and autonomous bodies.
- 24x7 Online Monitoring:
 - Acts as a transparent, effective, and proactive tool to track litigation cases in real time.
 - Covers the entire life cycle of a legal case.
- Stakeholder Integration:
 - Brings together users, nodal officers, and advocates on a single platform.
 - Enables seamless updates by all involved entities.

2. Functional Capabilities & Benefits

- User-Friendly GUI:
 - Allows easy entry and retrieval of case-wise litigation data.
 - Provides comprehensive reports for higher authorities and case managers.
- Automated Alerts:
 - SMS Alerts notify officials, advocates, and users about upcoming court cases to prevent delays or missed actions.
 - Helps ensure legal deadlines are met efficiently.

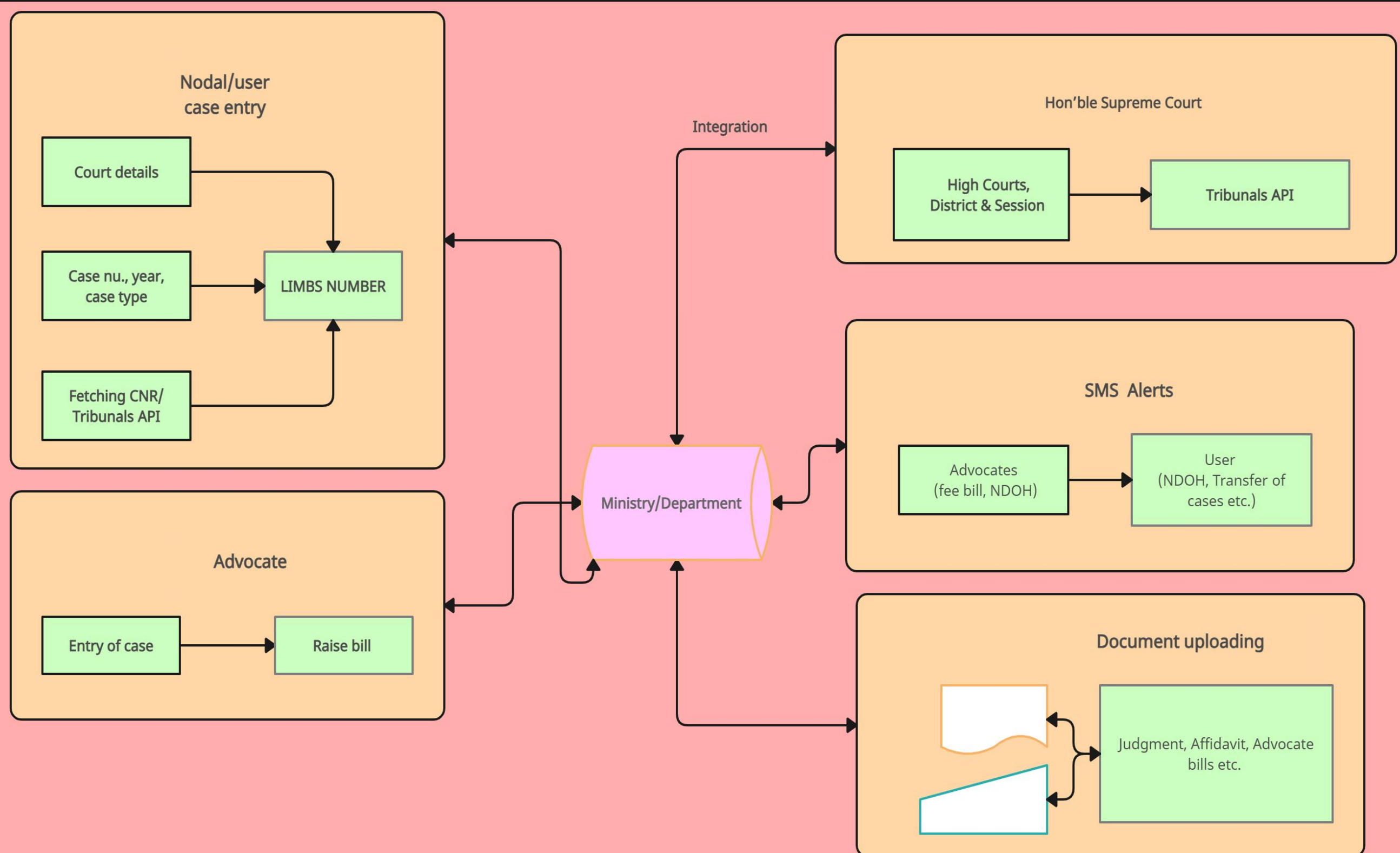
3. Governance & Legal Impact
